

# Annex 1 – Biosafety measures to be implemented when delivering feed in case of African swine fever: equipment

## 1) Equip vehicles with cleaning and disinfecting devices:

### a. Not installed on the vehicle:

- Backpack sprayers
- Plastic drums to store disinfection liquid
- brush

### b. Installed on the vehicle:

- automatic cleaning system

## 2) Protection equipment for the driver:

- Smooth-soled boots
- Disposable shoe covers
- Disposable jackets / overalls
- Disposable gloves

## 3) Disinfectants to be used:

See [list of authorised biocides](#) on the website of AFSCA-FAVV.

## 4) Vehicles should have sufficient dust bags

## 5) Disposable clothes and dust bags

Disposable clothes and dust bags shall stay in the company in dedicated containers

## 6) Disinfection:

- Every day, a fresh solution of the disinfectant must be prepared in compliance with the concentration and instructions for use provided by the manufacturer of the product. The stock must be placed in the truck in a plastic drum.
- Disinfect vehicles before entering (tires, wheel arches, footboard)
- When leaving the farm, all devices that have been in contact with the farm site (wheels, unloading pipe, ...) shall be sprayed with disinfection liquid. In case of obvious dirt (mud, dust, ...) a pre-cleaning must be performed.
- Disinfect your boots when leaving the farm

At the end of the operation, the driver should wash his hands with a (disinfecting) soap or otherwise disinfect his hands.

- 7) **Do not enter into the stables**, do not walk on the site if there is no need. If silos are inside the stables, discuss first with the farmer and, if needs be, use clothes made available by the farm.
